**Eligibility To Vote:** Every person, male or female, who shall have attained the age of 18 years on or before the date of the Annual Municipal Election and who shall be a qualified voter of the United States and a bona fide resident of the City of Lewes, shall have one (1) vote provided he/she is registered on the Books of Registered Voters for the City of Lewes. A citizen of the City of Lewes shall be deemed to include any person who is a qualified voter of the Sixth Senatorial District and the Third Councilmanic District of Sussex County, Delaware residing within the corporate limits of the City of Lewes. The Books of Registered Voters for the City of Lewes are kept in the Office of the City Manager. No person shall be registered upon such books unless they have acquired qualifications as stated. A person may register at the Office of the City Manager during regular business hours of such office until the close of business on the fifteenth day prior to the date of the Annual Municipal Election by completing the form prescribed by the City.

**Absentee Ballots:** Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, absentee ballot applications have been mailed to all registered and eligible voters. For those interested in voting absentee due to the COVID-19 pandemic, check the "I am sick or physically disabled" option on the affidavit. Applications for absentee ballots must be received no later than noon on July 17. Absentee ballots must be received no later than July 18 at 6:00 p.m. Absentee ballots received after this time will not be counted.
