



## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) City of Lewes 2021 Municipal Election**

This FAQ is intended to provide guidance and to answer questions to voters in navigating the absentee voting process for the City of Lewes.

The election is scheduled for May 8, 2021. Also, because many people are continuing to adhere to recommendations to stay at home and avoid crowds, the City of Lewes anticipates a higher number of voters than normal to vote via absentee ballot.

### **1. How do I get an application for an absentee ballot?**

You can either pick up an application at the City Hall window from 8:30 am-4:00pm (window closed for lunch from 1:00 pm-2:00 pm each day) OR you can obtain from the website <http://ci.lewes.de.us/273/Election-Information> .

### **2. How do I submit my absentee ballot application?**

You can either mail it to: City of Lewes, P.O. BOX 227, Lewes, Delaware. Attn: Absentee Ballot App. OR you can drop it off in the drop box in front of City Hall. OR you can email it to [election@ci.lewes.de.us](mailto:election@ci.lewes.de.us)

### **3. I am unsure if I am registered to vote, what should I do?**

Please email [election@ci.lewes.de.us](mailto:election@ci.lewes.de.us) to find out if you are registered or call City Hall during regular business hours at 302-645-7777.

### **4. When is my absentee ballot application due?**

They are due no later than noon the day before the election, which is May 7<sup>th</sup> this year.

### **5. When is my absentee ballot due?**

Absentee ballots are due no later than May 8<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. Absentee ballots received after this time will not be counted.

### **6. I would like to vote in person, what do I do?**

That is perfectly fine. No action is required right now if you wish to vote in person. The polling location will be open at City Hall on May 8<sup>th</sup> from 8am to 6pm. Please make sure to bring photo ID, wear a mask, and adhere to social distancing. There will be a limit of ten total individuals at a time in the building.
