CHAPTER 170 – ARTICLE IV – SECTION 29 SIGNIFICANT CODE IMPROVEMENTS

- Standards:

- Consideration shall be given for providing future sanitary sewer service to any or all potential lots created by a possible subdivision in any pre-existing approved subdivision before any entire street rehabilitation occurs.
- Consideration shall be given for providing future connection to the subdivision's sanitary sewer system from either existing or future users of the BPW sanitary sewer system.
- All sewer mains, manholes, flow channels, house service laterals, cleanouts, pump stations (and all pump station appurtenances), and other sanitary sewer system appurtenances, shall be designed, installed and inspected according to the current edition of the BPW Standard Specifications and Details.
- The Developer shall be responsible for the replacement and upsizing of downstream collection and/or transmission (pump stations/force mains) as necessary due to the proposed development's sanitary sewage flow. Downstream collection and transmission system effects shall be determined via analysis of the BPW sanitary sewer collection system model.
